Discussion Questions

Date: April 7, 2019 | **Scripture:** John 20:30-31

1. If the gospel is true, then that means we don't treat people who disagree with us badly or with disrespect. Many non-believers reject Jesus not because of the claims of the Bible, but the behavior of Christians. How might we pray that God would make us more gracious and loving to non-believers?
2. If the gospel is true, then we don't keep it quiet. 40% of millennials believe it is immoral to share your faith with others. 5% of American Christians invited someone to church last year. What do you think of these numbers? How might they compel us to *not* keep quiet?
3. If the gospel is true, then we first must see how much this matters in our lives. How have you lost sight of the gospel in your day to day? What does it look like to pray for brand new eyes in this regard?
4. If the gospel is true, then we must share it. We share what we love, but sometimes our loves get disordered. If someone were to look at your life over the past week, what would they say you love more than Jesus? Why do you think that is? How can your answer be different next week?
5. Because the gospel is true, Jesus still loves us the same even we fail to see its importance in our lives. Who might you share this good news with this week and invite to Easter Sunday?
