Discussion Questions

Date: April 14, 2019 | **Scripture:** John 12:12-19

1. Jesus' royal entrance on a donkey challenged the assumptions and expectations of the crowd. They saw him, but they didn't *really* see him. How have you missed Jesus' kingship in your own life?
2. Jesus doesn't simply say, "I *know* the way", but he says, "I *am* the way." How does this distinction change how we understand Christ's kingship?
3. No one gets to God except through Jesus. How is this both challenging and encouraging?
4. Anyone can get to God through Jesus. How is this both challenging and encouraging?
5. The first Palm Sunday and this past week's Palm Sunday point us to the Palm Sunday that's to come in Revelation 7:9. How does our future hope, that every tear will be wiped away, every wrong will be made right, and that we'll spend an eternity with God change how we live today?
6. We invite family, friends, neighbors to church not just that they can join our church family in McLean and Fairfax, but that they may join us in the heavenly crowd in the new heavens and new earth. How might this eternal perspective change how we do evangelism?

The purpose of Palm Sunday is to let you know that Jesus has come, that love now looks you in the eye. It points us to the ultimate Palm Sunday - the one that is to come in heaven where we will celebrate victory over death itself.
