Enjoying God: *The Father's Love*

Discussion Questions

Date: May 12, 2019 | **Scripture:** Matthew 6:25-33

1. Nothing robs us of our joy quite like worry. Share some examples in which you've experienced this to be true.
2. By referring to God as our "Heavenly Father" Jesus is inviting us to recognize God's supremacy in his creation and his intimacy in his provision. How have you recognized God's love in these areas in 2019?
3. If your faith is in Jesus Christ, when you meet your Heavenly Father face to face, He will receive you with joyous laughter and celebration as He says "Well done, good and faithful servant." How does this future hope inform how you receive the Father's love now?
4. We return the Father's love with the knowledge that our Heavenly Father already loves us as much as he possibly can. How does this understanding change how we approach obedience?
5. At the end of the sermon there were three application suggestions. At the end of each day... 1) Writing down a sign of God's love you experienced that day (recognize). 2) Writing down a couple of sentences of "thank you" for that sign (receive). 3) Writing down a righteous deed for the next day, and doing it (return). Have you tried these suggestions? What's it been like?
