





Discussion Questions

Date: May 19, 2019 | **Scripture:** Hebrews 4:14-16

1. Pastor David reflected over the question “With which member of the Trinity do you have strongest relationship - God the Father, God the Son, or God the Spirit?” How would you answer this question and why?
2. Because Jesus is our great High Priest, he sympathizes with our weakness because he is like us (fully human). He understands deep anguish, painful alienation, and unfulfilled longing. How does this understanding change how you relate to Jesus?
3. Because Jesus is our great High Priest, he has been tempted as we are yet without sin because he is unlike us (fully God). He knows temptation better than anyone because he was completely tempted and never gave in. How does this change how you relate to Jesus?
4. We live in a world that specializes in pretending in an attempt to cover our shame and inadequacy. In what ways do you try to cover your shame and inadequacy?
5. Pastor David encouraged us to imagine Jesus looking at us from heaven. What expression do you think is on his face and what would he say?
6. Pastor David encouraged us to write down our successes and failures, and to hear Jesus say, “I will remember their sins no more” and write across the page “finished and forgiven.” Have you tried this this week? What has the experience been like?
