- 1. Read Mark 12:28-34. What stands out to you?
- 2. "Which commandment is the most important of all?" wouldn't be asked in our relativistic culture. What are some of the consequences of living in a culture that places primacy on doing "whatever works for you"?
- 3. What do you daydream about? How does this reveal to you what you love?
- 4. Dr. Paul Jeon mentioned that when we choose where to live, we often make safety and education the most important deciding factor. How might putting too high an emphasis on these things compromise our ability to love our neighbors well?
- 5. Loving your neighbor means being generous with your time. Why is it difficult to be generous with time in this area? What might it look like to create margin in your day?
- 6. Loving your neighbor has to be an overflow of your love for the Lord. Share some experiences in which you've received love from a friend in which you knew it was an overflow of their love for Jesus.
- 7. Because Jesus first loved us, we are able to love God and love our neighbor. How have you experienced the love o Jesus in the month of June?
