Discussion Questions

**Date:** July 21, 2019 | **Scripture:** John 1:43-51

- 1. Read John 1:43-51. What stands out to you?
- 2. Philip's example shows us that seeing leads to sharing. How have you been seeing Jesus recently? Have you had an opportunity to help another person see Jesus?
- 3. Nathanael was initially skeptical about meeting Jesus. What was his first response about going to see Jesus? What do you think are some initial barriers that our neighbors/city/culture has to seeing Jesus?
- 4. Jesus saw Nathanael under the fig tree and Nathanael was astounded. Whatever took place at the fig tree, it is undeniable that Jesus was shocked or surprised, but comforting and tender. How should the truth that Jesus sees us and loves us the same change our everyday lives?
- 5. Not only did Jesus tell Nathanael that he saw him, but he also said that he will see even greater things. What greater things would Nathaniel eventually see? What amazing things have you seen God do in your life as you've followed Jesus?
- 6. As a community of faith, we can wrestle with hard questions and come alongside others who are questioning faith. Are there any big questions you are dealing with right now, and how can we as a group help you?
- 7. The road to discipleship usually comes through another person. Who has been someone who has been influential in your Christian life? Is there someone that you can invest in to help them see Jesus?
