

Answer the King: *Has No One Condemned You?* Discussion Questions **Date:** September 8, 2019 | **Scripture:** John 8:2-11

- 1. Read John 8:2-11. What stands out to you?
- 2. Imagine you were among the crowd as these events were taking place. What would be going through your mind as you witnessed everything? How would you feel if you were in the woman's position?
- 3. Rather than falling into the religious leaders' trap, Jesus instead exposes their hypocrisy. In our city and in our own lives, where is the temptation to act hypocritically particularly strong? How does hypocrisy hinder our ability to display the beauty of the gospel?
- 4. One of the fruits that come with following Jesus is humility (cf. John 8:9). How have you seen humility develop in your life as you have grown in grace? Do you find yourself becoming more aware of your own sin? How does having a humble heart help us to love others?
- 5. Although Jesus had the right to condemn the woman, he does not. Instead, he speaks a word of forgiveness. How is Jesus able to forgive this woman? How is Jesus able to forgive us? Knowing that there is no condemnation for those in Christ (Romans 8:1), what should be our response to the incredible love of Jesus?
- 6. After speaking a word of forgiveness, Jesus then gives the woman a charge of freedom. What does it look like to live in the freedom that Christ gives? Is there any area of your life where you are choosing to live in bondage to sin rather than bringing it to Jesus and being set free?

Jesus challenges us with questions too.
