ABOUT US

McLean Presbyterian Church exists to glorify and enjoy God by making disciples who make a difference through grace-filled worship, community, and missions. We are part of the Capital Pres Family: one church with multiple locations.

Our aim is to make disciples through three ministry areas: worship, community, and missions. While activity in each area does not equal discipleship, we are confident that these are the contexts needed for deep spiritual growth. In these contexts, we navigate the nuances of life in Christ together, and that's how we make disciples.

POSITION SUMMARY

We are seeking a Christ-centered individual to come alongside our Student Ministries and College team as we create a safe place for teens and current college students to find their God-given identity. This position provides the opportunity to invest in the lives of 150-200 students (middle school through college) while working closely with staff and volunteers.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Spiritual development is a key aspect of this internship. You will have a number of opportunities to grow in knowledge and depth of God's word as you seek to disciple and pursue Kingdom work alongside our staff. Responsibilities and areas of emphasis include, but are not limited to:

- ***Discipleship.*** This is the core of our ministry. You will assist staff in discipling our students through contact ministry: meaningful, personal relationships via regular one-on-one and group gatherings, texts, and other touch points. In addition, summer interns will be expected to participate in domestic summer mission trips (approximately 1-2 weeks).
- ***Teaching.*** You will have opportunities to develop and teach Biblically-based lessons designed to engage and equip our teens. This position will also coordinate and lead



our summer Bible study for college students and connect college students to our young adult ministry.

- ***Administration.*** Plan events, make announcements, coordinate attendance, contact work logistics, etc. - these responsibilities are at the core of helping our ministry run smoothly. You'll have an opportunity to oversee and direct these and other areas as needed.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- A genuine relationship with Jesus Christ and a vibrant, growing spiritual life
- Interest in and gifts for teaching the truths of Scripture
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills coupled with a desire to disciple teens; an ability to interact with students with grace and truth
- Organized, logistically-minded individual who is capable of assisting the Student Ministries team with helping our ministry run its day-to-day operations
- Mature disposition when communicating and meeting with parents, students, and adult/student volunteers
- Passionate embrace of MPC's philosophy of ministry, theology, and worship; familiarity with Reformed Theology
