Discussion Questions

Date: December 29, 2019 | **Scripture:** Mark 8:14-21

1. Read Mark 8:14-21. What stands out to you?
2. One of the greatest threats to our faith in the year ahead is forgetfulness—not remembering God and trusting in him. Why is forgetting God such a danger to our faith? What does it look like to be a forgetful Christ follower?
3. Have you gone through a period of time where you were forgetful of the Lord? What was that experience like, and how did God (or how is God) bring you through it?
4. A good way to jog our “gospel memories” is to remember what God has done in our lives. This is what Jesus does with his disciples in the passage. Looking back, how have you seen God provide for you this past year? What has he taught you about himself in 2019?
5. Another way to safeguard us against forgetfulness is to make a plan to remember Jesus in the future. What plans are you making to remember Christ in the following year? How do you intend to be more intentional in reading the Word, in prayer, in meeting together with God’s people?
6. As we look forward to what God will do in 2020, is there anyone in your life who is far from Christ? Let’s make it a goal to be more intentional in prayer for our unbelieving family, friends, coworkers, and neighbors, and ask that God would use us as he sees fit to show them Jesus.
