Discussion Questions

Date: April 12, 2020 | Scripture: <u>Luke 23:44-24:12</u>

- 1. Read <u>Mark 14:10-31</u>, <u>Mark 15:33-47</u>, and <u>Luke 23:44-24:12</u>. What stands out to you?
- 2. The drama of the Bible can be described in four movements—creation, fall, redemption, and restoration. How have you seen these themes play out in the Easter story?
- 3. At the Last Supper, we see that sin is cheap (Mk. 14:11) and that grace is expensive (14:22). What is it about sin that makes us so quick to sell out our Savior?
- 4. The crucifixion of Jesus (Mk. 15:33ff) shows us that it is sometimes more difficult for religious people to see Jesus than outsiders. Have there been moments where you have missed seeing Christ in your everyday life? What has kept you from seeing him?
- 5. The resurrection of Jesus (<u>Lk. 23:44ff</u>) reminds us that darkness will not last; light will eventually shine. How is the hope of the gospel different than the hope our world offers? How should it make a difference in your life?
- 6. The empty tomb teaches us that hope is not cancelled. How can you extend that hope to other people this week?
