Discussion Questions

Date: May 10, 2020 | Scripture: <u>John 10:11</u>

- 1. Read John 10:11-21. What stands out to you?
- 2. Jesus is the good shepherd who looks after his sheep. Sheep are helpless, dumb, and vulnerable creatures. How does this comparison confront our pride and challenge us to think about ourselves differently?
- 3. Even though Christ's sheep are helpless, dumb, and vulnerable, Christ is not a frustrated shepherd. How does Jesus as the good shepherd give us a different view of what God is like and how he thinks about us?
- 4. As our good shepherd, Jesus loves us more than life itself (vv. 10-13). Have you reflected on Christ's love for you recently? How amazing is it that Jesus laid down his life for you?
- 5. Jesus, our good shepherd, knows his sheep (v. 14). What emotions do you feel when you think about that God knows everything about you? How does the gospel tell us that it really is good news that God knows us?
- 6. The good shepherd gathers his sheep (v. 16). How is Jesus still doing this? How can we part of the gathering work that Jesus is doing?
