Discussion Questions

Date: June 7, 2020 | **Scripture:** Matthew 28:16-20

1. Read Matthew 28:16-20. What stands out to you?
2. Do you have plans to go anywhere this summer? What are you most looking forward to these next few months?
3. Before Jesus tells us to “go,” he wants to make sure we understand who he is (see v. 18). Why is getting this gospel order right so important? How does reversing the order undermine true Christianity?
4. By beginning with grace, we are free from striving and gaining approval from God or others. How does the gospel order reshape our hearts, posture, and attitude toward the world?
5. When we look at this passage (often called the Great Commission), we tend to think of global missions. But how is this Commission much more ordinary? What does it look like to live out this command in our everyday lives?
6. As you go this summer, what are some ways you can be more intentional when it comes putting your faith into action? How can we do that as a group? As a church?

Leaders: End your time in prayer for our neighbors and for our city, that God would do his work in individual lives and in communities. Pray for wisdom about how God is calling each one of us to participate in his kingdom work.
