

SESSION SUMMARY

Actions taken by the Session at its quarterly meeting, Tuesday, May 26, 2020.

Administrative:

1. Approved minutes of previous session meetings and changes in membership (submissions, transfers, etc.) submitted by the Clerk of Session.
2. Amended the Rules of Diaconate Operations and Rules of Session Operations to address virtual meetings.
3. Recommended to Presbytery to take Jeff Vogan and Jake Jenkins under care as they continue to develop the ministerial calls on their lives.
4. Approved the draft FY 2021 budget to be presented to the congregation at an informational meeting, to be held online on June 17. After presentation to and discussion by our members, the Session will vote to approve the final budget.
5. Approved the following individuals to be presented for election by the congregation at the annual meeting to serve as Ruling Elders and Deacons.
 - Ruling Elders: Stuart Burns, Tom Bennett, and John Renken. Chris Bargery, Jeff Mazanec, Donn Roebke, and Brad Waters were previously recommended by the Session on April 26, 2020.
 - Deacons: Don Brown, Hunter Gray, Cabbell Hobbs, Ken Janetsky, Ryan Ostrye, Adam Outlaw, Jon Sargent, and Kip Tatusko. James Arnold and Jeff Witkop were previously recommended by the Session on April 26, 2020.
6. Approved presentation to the congregation at the September annual meeting motions to establish the size of the Session (28 members) and Board of Deacons (40). The size of these boards is set by the congregation annually.
7. Approved the following individuals to serve on the Board of Women: Sharon Rose (first term), Annie Berry (second term), and Dominique McKay (second term). Jennifer Church, Jan Pascoe, Lauren Shannon, and Margaret Whisler were previously approved by the Session on April 26, 2020.
