Discussion Questions

Date: June 21, 2020 | Scripture: Luke 14:12-24

- 1. Read Luke 14:12-24. What stands out to you?
- 2. What's one of your favorite memories of a dinner party or feast that you've attended? Why does this memory stand out to you?
- 3. The context of this parable was Jesus' teaching not to be calculating in our relationships it is **not** about what we can **get** from others, **but how we can serve them** (v. 12-14). How have we been guilty of being transactional in our relationships? How can we encourage one another to serve others?
- 4. What does this parable of the great banquet (v. 16-24) teach us about the character of God?
- 5. As we read the gospels we realize how extraordinary Jesus truly is. What does this passage in particular reveal to you about Jesus?
- 6. Jesus convicts us here to examine ourselves the intimacy and relationship is not in <u>saying</u> that you will eat but <u>in the eating</u>. Are you fully partaking in this feast? Are there areas of your life that you avoid bringing to God's table? In other words, are there "second best things" keeping you from "the very best thing"?
- 7. We worship a God who is passionate about reaching us. He invites us to magnify our joy by participating in His work. What are some of the ways you can extend the invitation to the Great Banquet through evangelism this week?
