

Sermon Questions – Sept 6, 2020

The Gospel & Vocation

Ephesians 4:17-21

1. Read Ephesians 4:17-21. What stands out to you?
2. Looking at these verses, what words are associated with Gentiles (in this context, non-Christians)? How are these related to how non-Christians approach work?
3. How do you typically view work? Is it a necessary evil? Does it provide you with an undue sense of worth or shame? Reflect on why you have the feelings that you do about work.
4. Read Ephesians 2:13-19. How does this enunciation of the gospel – being made citizens and members of the household of God – tangibly change our approach to work?
5. Look at Ephesians 4:28. How does this challenge your understanding of work? Our work is meant to fuel our mission. What is one thing that you might “share” this week – with non-Christians, with fellow believers, with family?

For further study, explore these passages of Scripture. This week, the passages all reflect on the theme of labor and the gospel.
