Date: September 27, 2020 | Scripture: John 17:6-19

- 1. Read John 17:6-19. What stands out to you?
- 2. Read John 14:1, 16:6, and 16:32-33. How are the hearts of the disciples described? Drawing from the surrounding verses, why do you think their hearts were like this? Now think personally what is troubling your heart?
- 3. Read again John 17:11-15. What comfort can you take from the prayer of Jesus that you be kept in God's name and from the evil one?
- 4. Spend some time now praying for one another. Using your discussion from questions 2 and 3, pray for the needs that have come up.

Inward Grace in Action

The questions below are a little more intimate and are meant to be discussed with a trusted friend or partner.

- 1. The end of the sermon addressed three groups: pretenders, doubters, and skeptics, with a caution, comfort, and challenge for each respectively. Which of these groups have you been a part of in the past? Which best describes where you are right now? If none, how would you describe your current spiritual life?
- 2. To be kept in the name of God is to recognize the name that he give syou. What names have you given yourself, either currently or in the past? Rehearse the gospel to yourself and with a friend how does Jesus call you away from those names?
