

## Discussion Questions

Date: December 20, 2020 | Scripture: <u>Luke 1:46-56</u>

- 1. Read <u>Luke 1:46-56</u>. What phrases are particularly striking?
- 2. What are some experiences you have with power? Either yielding it, or being on the receiving end? Describe the feelings associated with those experiences.
- 3. How does this song invert those experiences of power?
- 4. Of the two groups sketched in Mary's song (the poor and lowly versus the rich and powerful), which do you identify with? Be honest!
- 5. Based on the group you identify with, what response does this song invite for you?

## Inward Grace in Action

The questions below are a little more intimate and are meant to be discussed with a trusted friend or partner.

- 1. Spend some time praying for the Lord to give you discernment to know your true status. Ask him to reveal areas of blindness, sin, arrogance, and pride.
- 2. Based on this song, it's clear that everyone needs to hear the news of the gospel. Who is one person that you will share the link to the Christmas Eve service with? Choose at least one person and invite them to watch on Christmas Eve. Follow up with them on Christmas Eve when you're planning to watch!
