



Discussion Questions

Date: *December 27, 2020* | **Scripture:** *Revelation 5:1-10*

1. Read [Revelation 5:1-10](#). What phrases are particularly striking?
2. God is worthy of our praise because he is the Creator (Revelation 4:11). Share together other reasons you have for praising God.
3. This passage of Scripture calls us to weep for our sin (5:3-4). As a group, pray aloud the Confession of Sin from the week. After, allow time for silent prayer.
4. Following your prayer, read Revelation 5:5-6. Then, read verses 9 and 10. How does Jesus' work help you to weep no more?
5. Reflect together on 2020. As this year draws to a close, what are ways you've seen God's provision? How does this give you hope for the new year?

Inward Grace in Action

The questions below are a little more intimate and are meant to be discussed with a trusted friend or partner.

1. With a friend or spouse, spend time confessing and mourning your sin. Together, look to Jesus. How does his work lead you to "weep no more?" From here, prayerfully reflect on the past year - ask the Spirit to give you courage and boldness to remember the hard and the good, and to teach you to praise Him in all of it.
