RECURRING EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

Sunday School: 11:00AM

Breaking Bread: 11:00AM

During these gatherings, Jr. and Sr. High students encounter God through fun games, worship, and Gospel-centered teaching. All students are encouraged to bring their friends! Grades 7 – 12 will meet together in the Multipurpose Room*

Tough Topics: 5:00 – 7:00 PM

At this event, Jr. and Sr. High students have the opportunity to engage in difficult conversations about relevant cultural issues (e.g. sex & sexuality, anxiety/depression, etc.) as a panel of "experts" from the Church attempt to answer their anonymous questions about topics like these and more. Grades 7 – 12 will meet together in the Multipurpose Room* and be split up by grade or gender as necessary.
