Date: January 24, 2021 | **Scripture:** <u>Acts 4:32-37</u>.

- 1. Read Acts 4:32-37. What stands out to you?
- 2. How would you describe the church in Northern Virginia? How do you think your neighbors and friends would describe it? Does this align with how you think God wants his church to be described?
- 3. Verse 32 describes a church of 'one heart and one soul'. While we are not called to agree over everything, when others look at our lives and our relationships with other Christians do they see a similar unity?
- 4. Verse 33 tells of a people with a message. How are we sharing the gospel message today? Are there ways we can be more intentional about sharing this message? Share ideas with your group.
- 5. If we are to be an extravagantly generous people as described in verses 34 and 35, we also need to know how to ask for help when we need it. Do you or does anyone you know have needs? Are these needs that could be met by our Deacon's fund or through service?

6. The power and grace of Jesus causes us to strengthen our bonds to others and loosen our grip on possessions. As we remember that we don't own our possessions, but are stewards of the resources God has given us, we find it easier to lay them down. How has the gospel changed you in the way you relate to others and how you relate to your possessions? How can you use your resources to help those around you?
