Sermon Questions

Date: *February 21, 2021* / **Scripture:** Acts 13:1-4; 14:19-28

1. Read Acts 13:44-14:18. We didn't read this in the service, so what stands out to you?
2. When you hear that it is God's goal for every person to know the gospel of Jesus Christ and he wants you to have a part in that, what feelings does that provoke?
3. Do you currently live as if the gospel is the only hope for the world? If an outsider objectively looked at your life, what would they see you living for?
4. There are three elements of church planting: Evangelism, discipleship, and leadership. Discuss the differences between these three as a group. Which are you most comfortable with? Which are you most uncomfortable with?
5. Have you ever been a part of a church plant or multi-site effort? Reflect and share on what that experience was like.
6. As a group, what are ways your Community Group might be more involved in the work of church planting?
