

Jesus and the Doubting Disciples - Loneliness Sermon Questions

Date: *April 4, 2021 |* Scripture: *Matthew 28:1-10*

- 1. Read all of Matthew 28. How do the three "episodes" of the text fit together?
- 2. Some of the disciples experienced doubt when they saw Jesus. What sorts of questions or doubts do you think they experienced?
- 3. What sorts of doubts or questions about Jesus have you experienced in life? Are they resolved? If so, how were they addressed?
- 4. What experiences do you have with authority? How is the fact that Jesus holds all authority good news?
- 5. What part of the "Great Commission" (verses 19-20a) is most challenging for you? How can you encourage one another to be faithful in this command?
- 6. Why do you think Jesus ended the Commission with the comfort that he is with us always? How does this empower us?

- Which part of this passage Jesus' authority, his command, or his comfort - do you need to recognize the most this week?
- 2. Spend some time in prayer together praying these realities over each other.
