

Sermon Questions: Saving Grace **Date:** May 9, 2021/ **Scripture:** Ephesians 2:1-10

- 1. Read Ephesians 2:1-10. Based on this passage, what is true of us? What is true of God? Make a list for each!
- 2. Verses 1-3 present the bad news that makes grace necessary. How do these verses make you feel? Where do you see the truth of them in your own life?
- 3. Look again at verses 8 and 9 in the passage. We are saved by grace, not our works. In what ways are you tempted to "work" for your salvation?
- 4. Read Ephesians 2:10 and Romans 6:1-4. Grace saves us from sin to life. Compare Ephesians 2:1-3 with verse 10. How does your life display God's workmanship?
- 5. God's grace is costly. How does remembering the great cost of God's grace empower us to live today?

1. In what areas of your life are you still sinning? How does this passage change your perspective? Confess honestly to your partner and pray for one another.
