

Sermon Questions: Gifts, Part 3

Date: June 20, 2021 | Scripture: Ephesians 4:11-16

- 1. Read Ephesians 4:11-16. What do you think it means to "grow up into Christ" (v. 15)? How is this contrasted with being a child in verse 14?
- 2. "Truth" can be a slippery subject in today's world. What is your experience with truth as a concept do you find most of your friends and coworkers affirm universal truth? How might you respond to those who say all truth is relative?
- 3. Describe a time when someone has told you the truth in love what did they say? How did they say it? What was the result?
- 4. Love is a fundamental part of the Christian life. Read John 16:12-17. How does Christ's love for us impact how we love those in the church?
- 5. Reflect together about your individual lives and your life together as a CG. Where have you seen growth? Pray together and thank God for his grace in these areas!
