



SESSION SUMMARY

Actions taken by the Session at its called meeting, Wednesday, June 16, 2021.

- Following the congregational meeting, approved the FY 2022 budget, as presented to the congregation.
- Approved the FY 2022 budget of our church plant, King's Cross Church.

Actions taken by the Session at its quarterly meeting, Tuesday, July 20, 2021.

- Released \$700K from General Fund for Session designated priorities (the Diaconate's Stewardship recommended this amount based on the General Fund surplus from FY2020). These priorities included:
 - \$25K to the PCA Unity Fund which provides scholarships to men of diverse minority backgrounds seeking ordination in the PCA
 - \$50K to the Church Plant Seed Fund
 - \$150K to the Mission Benevolence Fund to aid mission partners
 - \$200K for Audio/Visual/Lighting upgrades to the Sanctuary
 - \$275K to the Future Growth Fund to support the building project
- Committed the Session to a time of biblical reflection and prayer related to racial reconciliation and endorsed a plan to provide materials for use by Community Group leaders, adult education classes, and others to provide opportunities to reflect, pray, and process the topic of racial and ethnic reconciliation.
- Approved the Session Committee assignments for 2021-2022 (see below).
- Approved the calendar for officer nomination, training, and examination.
- Approved minutes of previous session meetings and changes in membership (submissions, transfers, etc.) submitted by the Clerk of Session.

Actions taken by the Session at its called meeting, Thursday, August 5, 2021.

1. Reaffirmed our current regathering practice in light of the changing guidance related to COVID. Further requested investigation if an additional masked service or outdoor service would be practical or beneficial.

1. Called a meeting of the congregation of our church plant, King's Cross Church, to approve composition of their Session and Diaconate, elect officers, and consider
