

Sermon Questions: *The Wise and Foolish Builders* Date: *October 10, 2021* | Scripture: <u>Matthew 7:24-27</u>

- What is the difference between the houses in the parable? Consider beginning, middle and end.
- 2. What do the builders have in common in the parable?2. What is the difference that Jesus is illustrating in this.
- 3. What is the difference that Jesus is illustrating in this parable?
- 4. Foundations are costly, expensive and time-consuming. How is this true in various areas of life? How is it true spiritually? Consider answers from scripture and your own experience.
- 5. We grieve with hope, suffer without despair, and cry out with trust. Both houses faced the storm, as will all followers of Jesus. Consider what blessings God does promise in this life (see box) and consider where you have seen these in believers facing suffering.
