Date: February 13, 2022 | Scripture: <u>1 Peter 3:1-7</u>

- 1. Read 1 Peter 3:1-7. Name things that you find beautiful, difficult or unfamiliar in these verses.
- 2. Look at the ends of verses 2, 4, 6 and 7. What is the aim of the behavior Peter is describing? How might beginning with the end in mind affect how we read these commands?
- 3. This teaching for wives in v1-6 is countercultural today, just as it was then. Talk about the tensions and blessings of living this way today.
- 4. When husbands are commanded to show honor to their wives in v7, the same word is used as that in 2:17 for 'honor the emperor.'
 Talk about the tensions and blessings of living this way today.
- 5. In what ways can Christian marriage show the world something of Christ?
