

Sermon Questions

Date: *May 22, 2022* | Scripture: <u>1 Corinthians 15:50-57</u>

- 1. Read 1 Corinthians 15:50-57
- 2. Knowing the whole story of the Bible and our place in it is essential. In your group work together to summarize the four-chapter gospel in a way that you could share with someone who asks.
- 3. This promise that we will all be changed in a moment is both an encouragement to believers and a warning to those who don't believe (cf. 1 Thess. 5). Share with your group people you are praying for to embrace the gospel.
- 4. Paul is so confident in Christ's victory here that he taunts death. However, living after Resurrection and before Consummation, there are times when it feels like death has won. What are some of the ways we can glorify God and remind each other of His supremacy in those hard times?
- 5. God created us with a longing for resolution and victory. Because of the fall we are tempted to put our hope for victory in other things. Where are some of the places you have the propensity to go for hope?
- 6. What difference does it make to live in the comfort that you belong to Christ as described in the Heidelberg Catechism below?

Heidelberg Catechism Question 1

Q. What is your only comfort in life and in death?

A. That I am not my own, but belong—body and soul, in life and in death—to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ.

He has fully paid for all my sins with his precious blood, and has set me free from the tyranny of the devil. He also watches over me in such a way that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven; in fact, all things must work together for my salvation.

Because I belong to him, Christ, by his Holy Spirit, assures me of eternal life and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him.
