



Sermon Questions

Date: *May 29, 2022* | Scripture: *1 Corinthians 15:58*

1. Read 1 Corinthians 15:58.
2. Reflect on all the resurrection matters covered in 1 Corinthians 15. What truth has been most surprising? Most challenging? Most comforting?
3. Paul concludes his entire discourse on resurrection matters with the call to be “steadfast, immovable, [and] always abounding in the work of the Lord.” In what way does his discourse connect with this call?
4. What does Paul mean when he refers to “the work of the Lord”? Consider reading 1 Corinthians 16, with special attention to verses 5-11.
5. In 1 Corinthians 12, Paul explains the diverse spread of gifts and skills Christians are given in their unified mission of the church. How might you partner with the church in furthering the proclamation of the gospel?

6. Where in the life of the church do you feel your labor has been in vain? Praying for healing of those with ongoing needs? Confessing your sins? Serving in Children’s Church? Helping with the Welcome Center?
7. How does the resurrection breathe steadfast life into your feelings of vanity and meaninglessness?
