

Sermon Questions

Date: *June 5, 2022* | Scripture: *Acts 2:1-13*

- 1. Read Acts 2:1-13. How does Luke, the writer, communicate through this passage the reversal of the events of Babel (Genesis 11)?
- 2. This passage, in which all these people hear the apostles speaking in their own languages, is immediately followed by Peter's first sermon, in which he preaches the gospel of Jesus Christ. What does this tell us about the Spirit's priorities?
- 3. Jesus taught his disciples in John 14 that he would send his Spirit, and that this would be better for them than that he stay. How can this be better, for them and for us?
- 4. The sending of the Spirit is the climax of the great redemptive work of Jesus. How does it relate to all we have seen about the resurrection these past seven weeks?
- 5. What does the indwelling of the Spirit in believers mean for you as you face life?

- 6. What difference does the Holy Spirit make to the problem of loneliness? Consider 1 Corinthians 12:12-27.
- 7. If Christ has sent his Spirit to live in you, what does that mean for the purpose of your life?
