Date: September 11, 2022 | Scripture: Mark 1:1-15

- 1. What is the most important message you've received recently? What did it call you to do?
- 2. Read the passages from the sermon together. What do you find convicting? What do you find challenging? What do you find confusing?
- 3. Mark's Gospel message goes out to a conflicting kingdom. Jesus finds opposition against Satan, Rome, and the religious authorities of his day. Where do you experience conflict for following Jesus, whether spiritual, political, social, or religious?
- 4. Jesus enters into the wilderness of our broken lives to wage war against sin. How does Jesus meet you specifically in your wilderness suffering?
- 5. Where are you tempted to follow other kings, or to make yourself your own king?

6. The Gospel of Mark tells us that Jesus is king, that this is the most important news you'll receive today or any day, and that the message is for you. What is your response to this message? Jesus calls us to repent and believe. How can you be practicing both repentance and belief this week?
