

Sermon Questions Date: January 15, 2023 | Scripture: Mark 9:30-50

- Read the passage from the sermon together. If you worshipped at our Fairfax site, read Mark 9:38-50 as well. What do you find convicting? What do you find challenging? What do you find confusing?
- 2. The disciples squabbled about who among them was the greatest. What do you think they might have been using as their standard of greatness?
- 3. How are we like the disciples? How do we have a competitive spirit? How does that play out when we think about the other churches in our area or ministries within our spheres?
- 4. How did Jesus model and embody his own teaching here?
- 5. Who are the most humble and lowly in society today? Who are the people on the margins of the church? Do you know any such people personally?
- 6. How might we as a church, or you as a community group, or you as an individual notice and serve such people?
