## Date: January 29, 2023 | Scripture: <u>Mark 10:17-31</u>

- Read the passage from the sermon together. What do you find convicting? What do you find challenging? What do you find confusing?
- 2. What do you situate your life around? What does your calendar say you situate your life around? How about your bank account?
- 3. How often do you think about eternity? What do you think of it?
- 4. Do you tend toward the mindset of "doing enough" to inherit eternal life like the rich man or "giving enough" like Peter? What does that look like for you?
- 5. How often do you view money as a danger to your faith in God? How do you manage that danger?
- 6. Jesus, out of love, gives a pointed response to both the rich man and to Peter. What is the one thing you need to hear from Jesus about your eternal future?

## Inward Grace in Action

Jesus' response to Peter affirms the sacrifice he and the other disciples had made, but also reminds him of the immense blessing he's received in the community of people who follow Jesus. Believers today still share in that blessing.

- What was a time your brothers and sisters in Christ showed up in your life?
- How can you be a brother or sister in Christ and provide for someone in your church community?

**ACTION:** Find one way to serve a brother or sister in our church family in the next month—whether it be signing up for a meal train or writing
