John Dickson, our guest speaker for the missions conference and preacher for McLean and Reston this Sunday, described three types of doubt: intellectual, things you can investigate through research; moral, things the Bible teaches which push against your understanding of what is right or wrong; and psychological, the natural resistance of accepting something that has huge implications for life. - 6. How does the person of Jesus encourage you as you process your doubts?
- 7. How does the person of Jesus encourage you as you share your faith with others who have doubts?
