



Sermon Questions

Date: *August 13, 2023* | Scripture: *Psalm 145*

1. Read the passage from the sermon together. What do you find convicting? What do you find challenging? What do you find confusing?
2. This psalm opens with the command to “extol” the Lord. To extol someone or something is to lift up, to celebrate and honor and rejoice. What is the last thing you literally, physically extolled?
3. What do you find yourself naturally extolling throughout the course of life? Who are the people and what are the things you regularly lift up and celebrate?
4. How was this Psalm sung by Jesus? How can we sing this Psalm about Jesus?

Inward Grace in Action

This psalm emphasizes passing on the faith to the next generation.

- What are some ways you can commend the faith to the next generation?
- What makes cross-generational connection difficult?
- How does the gospel reconcile generations to each other?
