POSITION SUMMARY

The Production Lead oversees the setup and operation of the Audio, Video, and Lighting (AVL) equipment for the McLean campus. The Production Lead will assist the Director of Technology in training and empowering volunteers to provide AVL services for Sunday worship. Most working time will be spent on Sundays supporting morning services and then preparing for the evening service (approx. 6-7 hrs.) with additional communication, planning, and preparation to be completed during the week (approx. 4-5 hrs.)

- Oversees the successful preparation and operation of AVL systems in corporate worship for Sunday mornings.
- Assists in recruiting, scheduling, developing and supervising volunteer audio, video, and projection operators for Sunday worship services.
- Performs first-tier Sunday AVL troubleshooting.
- Contributes to the development of systems and processes to effectively serve and support the AVL needs of McLean Pres.
- Assists in maintaining McLean Pres. AVL equipment.
- Serves as AVL tech for McLean Pres events as needed.
- Opportunities to serve as AVL tech for third-party events (weddings, funerals, and conferences) as needed.
