Core Questions

- 1. Share and discuss your pre-study notes.
- 2. In which contexts are you encountering conflict or confusion around questions or distortions of gender? How has God's design helped you to address these?
- 3. The sermons talked about God's design, our distortion, God's redemption, and our response. Of these, do any tend to bring you joy, and do any tend to bring cognitive dissonance?
- 4. Our confusion around gender has accelerated, but is not new. Where have you defined gender roles unbiblically in a way that functionally denies the image of God? Or where have you felt an unbiblical use of these concepts to deny your dignity?

Inward Grace in Action

5. When the Bible teaches things that disagree with the things everyone else calls good, we can fear that the position we hold is everything it is accused of: hateful, bigoted, and thoughtless. If the position comes from God's word, what difference does his character make to how we understand the position?

Outward Grace in Action

6. Freedom to decide our own gender places enormous pressure on us to be the highest authority and point of reference for our very self. In what ways does the good news of the gospel free us from this pressure?
