Date: November 26, 2023 | Scripture: Leviticus 19:33-34

- 1. Read the passage from the sermon together. What do you find convicting? What do you find challenging? What do you find confusing?
- 2. God commands his people to love strangers in their midst as they love themselves. How does Israel's history inform the importance of this law? Why might Israel struggle to live this law out?
- 3. God roots this command to Israel in himself by saying "I am the Lord your God." How does loving strangers reflect God's image?
- 4. Have you ever felt like a foreigner? When have you been the stranger or outsider? What was that like?
- 5. Who are the strangers, foreigners, and outsiders in your community?
- 6. One of the key ways we show God's love to strangers is through hospitality. What does good Christian hospitality entail?
