Core Questions

- 1. How did Daniel's dual identities create tension and opportunity for him to serve?

4. Fear, desire for comfort, and many other motivations can drive us to expressions of isolation or assimilation. Which way to you tend to go? How does this affect your ability to serve to God's glory, and what would be lost if you repented?

Outward Grace in Action

5. Where is God sending you to serve? Are there people you are aware of whom you could be serving, loving, and telling about Jesus? Prayerfully commit to obedient action, and share these convictions with the group.
