## Introduction

Christianity Explored (CE) is a seven-week curriculum designed to help people meet Jesus as he walks off the pages of Scripture. CE exists to introduce nonbelievers to Jesus in a friendly, noncoercive way so that they might come to know him.

The CE course is for anyone who wants to think about the meaning of life. There's no requirement to know anything about the Bible, nor is there pressure to speak, pray, or sing. CE invites anyone who's curious about Christianity to come and enjoy a meal with Christians who are open to their questions. The course meets once a year and looks at Jesus' life as written in Mark.
