Introduction

Kibera in Nairobi, Kenya is the largest urban slum in Africa, with an area of one square mile and a population of close to 250,000. Through the leadership of Imbumi and Martha Makuku, Kibera Reformed Presbyterian Church provides ministries meeting the spiritual, social, physical, and mental needs of the families living there. Ministries include Sunday services, Bible studies, a school for children in grades 1-5, and a family home which safely houses children facing abuse or abandonment.
