TRIO FACILITATOR'S ROLE

- Commit to praying with and for your Trio members both during and outside of your meetings
- Attend a 90-minute training session to provide you with guidelines to effectively lead a Trio.
- Attend all monthly All-Trios meetings (see schedule at mcleanpres.org/wdw) unless unavoidable.
- Communicate to WDW planning team any concerns or needs.
