- 1. Shiphrah and Puah acted in faith and courage despite the immediate danger from Pharaoh.
  - Can you think of a time in your life when you had to trust God in the middle of uncertainty or fear?
  - How does Exodus 1:15-21 show us that God values ordinary acts of faithfulness?
- 2. Exodus 1:22 describes the horrifying reality of Pharaoh's decree.
  - How does this passage challenge the way we think about evil in the world today?
  - How can we hold on to the hope of God's justice when evil feels overwhelming?
- 3. Moses' mother placed him in the Nile as an act of faith, trusting God to protect him.
  - What are the "basket moments" in your life—times when you've had to surrender control to God?
  - How does remembering God's past faithfulness give us courage to trust Him with our future?
- 4. Moses, with all his flaws, was used by God to deliver His people.
  - Why do you think God often chooses imperfect people to accomplish His purposes?
  - How does this encourage you to step into God's calling on your life, even with your weaknesses?
- 5. Christ: The Ultimate Deliverer
  - o How does Jesus' life, death, and resurrection demonstrate God's power over evil?
  - o In what ways can the redemptive reality of Christ inspire and equip you to face overwhelming challenges in your own life?
