## **Core Questions**

- 1. Exodus 7:14-25 and 10:21-29 demonstrate God's unmatched power over creation. What do these plagues reveal about God's character? How do they demonstrate his authority over earthly powers and nature?
- 2. Considering Pharaoh's hardened heart and the plagues, how does this passage point us to our own condition as sinners? How is Pharoah rejecting God as both Creator and Savior?
- 3. In Exodus, Pharaoh's refusal to repent shows the danger of hardening our hearts. Read Hebrews 12:1-2. How can fixing our eyes on Jesus help us avoid the hardening of our hearts and stay faithful in our reliance on God for His grace?

4. This passage reveals the depth and power of God. How are you reconciling this big view of God in your heart? Where is a place in your heart that you are afraid to acknowledge God's lordship?
