Core Questions

4. When we recognize an idol in our hearts, what practical steps can we take to turn from it and refocus our worship on God? How can we learn to avoid just “managing our sin”?

5. When God is our greatest desire, how does that communicate our priorities to the world? How can our battle with idolatry become a form of evangelism?
