Core Questions

- 1. Jesus' entry into Jerusalem on a donkey fulfilled Old Testament prophecy (e.g., Zechariah 9:9). What does this teach us about God's faithfulness and sovereignty?
- 2. In verses 41–44, Jesus weeps over Jerusalem. What does His lament reveal about His heart for the lost?

Inward Grace in Action

- 3. Palm Sunday begins the week leading to the cross and resurrection. How can this passage help prepare our hearts to walk through Holy Week and remember what Jesus did for us?
- 4. Jesus came as a humble King, not the kind of ruler people expected. In what ways are we tempted to want a version of Jesus who fits our own plans or comforts, rather than following Him as He truly is?
