Core Questions

1. What does it mean that “the glory of the Lord filled the Tabernacle” (v. 34)? How is this a pivotal moment in the history of God’s covenant with Israel?
2. Why did God give such detailed and specific instructions for the construction of the Tabernacle? What does this reveal about His nature and His desire for His people?”

Inward Grace in Action

3. How does the Tabernacle in Exodus 40 point forward to the ultimate presence of God with His people in Christ (John 1:14 – “The Word became flesh and dwelt among us”)? How does “God who dwells with us” show his character and love for us?
4. The Tabernacle was the place for Israel to come before God in worship: it is incredibly meticulous. How does our worship today reflect the same reverence and awe for God’s presence? Are there aspects of your own worship that need to be re-examined or renewed in light of God’s glory?

Outward Grace in Action

5. In Exodus 40:36-38, the Israelites followed the cloud and fire wherever it went. Today, God is calling us into the world to make disciples. How does our “God with us” encourage us to faithfully make him known to our world around us?
