ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Missions:

- Develop and execute strategic vision to ensure spiritual growth continues to produce outward-facing disciples locally and globally throughout the MPC church family and MPC Missions partners.
- Orchestrate the strategic direction of all Missions ministries to ensure integration and cohesion adhering to the established missional priorities of:
 - > Church Planting (Local & International)
 - > Evangelism
 - > Mercy
 - > Cultural Renewal
- Under direction of Senior Pastor, own all day-to-day management of staff-driven and volunteer-driven Missions Ministries.

Application:

- Local Evangelism: Develop vision, strategy, and leadership of MPC's local evangelism efforts, taking primary responsibility for driving local outreach so MPC continues to reach those who are far from God. These ministries include Christianity Explored, MOMCo, ESOL, Nursing Home Ministry, Young Life.
- Local Mercy: Develop mercy ministry outreach to the DC area, in conjunction with the Deacons, providing strategic leadership, support, and accountability. Ministries include The Lamb Center, Casa Chirilagua, SHARE, Assist & Capitol Hill Pregnancy Centers and Project Belong.

Global Missions:

- Missionary Care: Develop and execute a clear vision for missionary care for Local and Global partners from the beginning of the partnership process, fielding requests for support, to active partnership, all the way through to termination of support.
- Communications and Engagement: Engage the congregation to better connect with our missions partners and foster a proactive perspective that moves MPC from just explaining Missions to getting the congregation invested. This includes exploring key communications and media for partners via the web, existing print pieces, prayer guides, events, and partnerships with internal MPC ministries.
- Provide strategic leadership, coordination, support, and accountability for all worship and community ministries in order to advance missions.
- Oversee and direct the planning, leader/team training, and execution of all missions trips.
- Regularly visit overseas partners in their context to encourage, support and observe.
- Events: Execute all aspects related to the yearly Missions Conference
 - Develop a theme and program.
 - Secure keynote speakers in conjunction with the Pastors.
 - Coordinate with staff for tailored communications.
 - Organize all logistics associated with the main event(s), including recruiting volunteers and assisting in the development of the Children's Mission Program.
- Assist the Senior Pastor as needed in the operational success of all aspects of MPC/s church planting efforts.
- Provide influence and support to missions ministries at MPC sites and church plants.

Leadership:

- Under direction of the Senior Pastor, serve as primary contact and staff liaison for the Missions Committee of the Session. Provide vision, direction, and structure to the work of this committee.
- o Oversee the ministry interns (Pastoral/Ecclesial/Summer) assigned to Missions.
- o Participate in staff life devotions, staff training, retreats, etc.
- Other duties as assigned.
