## Core Questions

1. What is a disciple? What is a specifically Christian disciple?
2. Where else in scripture can you remember God sending people?
3. How does reading and applying Matthew 28:16-20 change when remembering that this is a corporate call to the church rather than something to be fulfilled by individuals in isolation?
4. How does baptism contribute to the task of making disciples?
5. Why is it important that Matthew ends his gospel account the way he does?

## Inward Grace in Action

1. What are your initial internal reactions when you come to this passage? Did the sermon address some of those reactions?
2. Who are some people who have discipled you? What did that look like?
3. How have you experienced Jesus' presence as you've participated in the disciple-making mission?

## Outward Grace in Action

1. What are some of the variety of ways that we can respond to the command to "go"?
2. Who is the Lord calling you to "see" and have "compassion" for? How does compassion inform our discipleship? (Matthew 9:36)

For Families: Ideas of how to keep the conversation going at home, in the car, or around the dinner table:

1. **A - Ask about the message:** ask your children if they know who Jesus' disciples were. Ask them if they know what a disciple is?
2. **S - Share your thoughts:** Tell your children about some of the people who have played a large role in discipling you.
3. **K - Keep it going:** Ask your children who your family can pray for, that they might become disciples of Jesus.

*Reflect* on these passages that trace the theme of grace changing everything throughout the scriptures:
