PRAYER GUIDE



Pray each week leading up to, during, and after our Youth Ministry Scotland Mission Trip:

WEEK 1 | June 1-5: Preparation & Surrender

“Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will be established.” – Proverbs 16:3

- For humility and teachability across the team
- For eagerness to serve over a desire to “experience”
- That God would begin preparing the hearts of our team, our partners in Scotland, and the Scottish students
- For surrender of expectations, comfort, and control
- For dependence on the Lord in fundraising and logistics

WEEK 2 | June 8-12: Unity & Teamwork

“Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.” – Ephesians 4:3

- For deep community, trust, and vulnerability
- For protection from division, comparison, or miscommunication
- For cohesive teamwork and strong leadership dynamics
- For each person to feel seen, valued, and supported by leaders and teammates
- That the team learns to carry one another well

WEEK 3 | June 15-19: Provision & Logistics

“And my God will supply every need of yours according to His riches in glory in Jesus Christ.” – Philippians 4:19

- That we would meet and/or exceed our \$55k fundraising goal
- For peace for teens who are feeling anxious about fundraising
- For safe and smooth travel and overall health
- That logistical details would come together without stress
- That reliance on God grows wherever practical needs arise

WEEK 4 | June 22-26: Courage & Faith

“For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.” – 2 Timothy 1:7

- For courage to boldly live out our faith as we step outside our comfort zones
- That fear, insecurity, or hesitation would not take root
- For boldness that is grounded in Jesus’ love and not pressure from the world’s expectations
- That our teens would be ready to share their faith authentically
- That God prepares specific conversations and divine encounters

WEEK 5 | June 29-July 3: Humility & Service

“Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count other more significant than yourselves.” – Philippians 2:3

- For humility and cultural sensitivity
- For a posture of listening, learning, and honoring local leaders
- For a strong partnership with Young Life Scotland
- That our team would serve faithfully, not seeking recognition
- For 130 campers to encounter Jesus and for endurance (physical, spiritual, and emotional) throughout the week

WEEK 6 | July 6-10: Reflection & Lasting Fruit

“I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. So, neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth.” – 1 Corinthians 3:6-7

- For our team to process and reflect deeply on the trip
- That what God did (in our own hearts and in Scotland) would not fade but have a lasting impact on our lives
- For continued spiritual growth back home
- That the relationships built would continue to bear fruit
- For testimonies to encourage and strengthen the church and deepen our missional heart moving forward
